AIR TRAGEDY  
BOMBER FALLS INTO SEA.

Picture.:- Off the Havre suburb of Saint-Adresse, the sole survivor, Flying Officer Page takes part in the operations for raising the sunken air-bomber in which he crashed some days ago. At low tide the under-carriage wheel is visible. A diver descends to assist in the fixing of cables by which the aircraft will be raised. You will recall that the disaster was caused by the 'plane losing its way, petrol giving out, and the attempted descent on to the sea.

Three men were drowned. A great derrick slowly exerts its power, and the remains of the aircraft steadily begins to show itself above the waters, which so tragically engulfed it. (EFFECTS)

(EFFECTS - 2SHOTS)

The crash was the second on the same night exercises, news of which regrettable losses, shocked and horrified us.<sup>22</sup> We opened our early morning papers.
