Cologne, under the shadow of the great Cathedral, towering edifice, symbolising the Glory of God and the Christ who died that others might live, rings to the ominous clank of armed men, upon whom girls threw flowers in their here worship.

Berlin. The Leader himself, upon whom the responsibility for the recent drastic move rests, drives

into the Wilhelmstrasse after

his critical speech in the Reichstag, speech which made the diplomatic wires almost red hot

with high tensioned activity. Hundreds of

thousands of Germans cheered his action to the echo. A torchlight procession, appearing almost un-ending

in length, made up of

soldiers of the old German armies marched before Herr Hitler, who watches from a baleony.
