Depot. It is brought by 'F' Battery of the Royal Horse

of three British sovereigns to their last rest. Queen
Victoria,

King Edward VII and King George. Four gum-teams of
the 'F' Sphinx

Battery are drawn up on the parade ground for the
oeremony of handing the-gum-carriage over. After this parade it will be given
a permanent home at the Depot.
