## CEREMONY AT WOOLWICH

### Picture.:-

A gun-carriage arrives at the Woolwich Royal Artillery Depot. It is brought by 'F' Battery of the Royal Horse Artillery, and it has done service which no

other gun-carriage can claim. It has borne the bodies of three British sovereigns to their last rest. Queen Victoria,

King Edward VII and King George. Four gun-teams of the 'F' Sphinx

Battery are drawn up on the parade ground for the ceremony of handing the--

gun-carriage over. After this parade it will be given a permanent home at the Depot.

### Men in the march

past include those gun-teams who took part in the funeral of King George. The Sphinx Battery is in the picturesque

pre-war uniforms of the Royal

Horse Artillery. I understand that the now historic gun-carriage is received by

the Depot under a provision in the will of His Late Majesty.
