Here is a sidelight on the situation in Kenya, where the sidelight is a delegation of Conservative and Labour M.P.'s kn' Walfu Ellistico

On a tour of fact-finding. On the one side, they inspected a new housing estate at Port Tudor, where the Municipality are putting up modern homes to be let at cheap remtals to African families.... and Mr Wakefield M.P. is lending a shovel.

So much for the activities of peace; But a few miles from the township of Nyeri, Kikuyu men and women are digging defence ditches of a new Guard Post --- building a stronghold against the attacks of Mau Mau. And in conversation with a Kikuyu Home Guard Mr Elliot is gathering material for his report to Parliament. Here, during the emergency it is necessary to keep the youngsters fully occupied with games --- organised by the Kenya Police to keep them out of mischief during slack periods.

During their tour of the district the M.P.'s inspected crops
that had been grown by prisoners They talked also with Mrs
Breckenridge, wife of the Labour Officer, who is the only white
woman at the post. Then --- to the Athi Rehabilitation Camp for
Mau Mau prisoners. This is situated in the open veldt, about
twenty-five miles from Nairobi. One of the Tehabilitation officers
at this camp is the son of a Kikuyu chief who was murdered by
Mau Mau. Behind the bars are the worst of the prisoners; one of
them attempted to present a petition to the delegation from London
