A writer who lives as dangerously as the heroes of his own stories..... Mr Ernest Hemingway. The author of such tough epics as Far Whom The Bell Tolls and The Snows of Kilimanjaro is here seen on arrival at Nairobi after two plane crashes and a night lost in the jungle. Mrs Hemingway had been with him ---but she stayed resting at Entebbe after the second crack-up.

In Kenya the latest development in the war against Mau Mau, is the signing of a joint declaration by twenty-three Kikuyu chiefs. It points out that self-Government can never be achieved by nurder and massacre. The declaration appeals for informat ion that will help to uncover and defeat the jungle gangsters; it praises the fight that hovalists are putting up in defence of their yomen and children. It asks for unity, to make Kenya once more a land of peace and progress.
