France in the cross-country cycling season has started. Eighty competitors took part in the International at Mount Valerien in near Paris --- only to find out how deep is my valley. In --- It was rough, tough going all the way. The winner was the Frenchman Jodet. In Germany --- in the Hartz Mountains not far from Hanover --- they held the German Bobsled Championship of 1954.

The winners were the Olympic champions, Nieberl and Ostler. There were plenty of crashes --- but no one was badly injured.

Now to Belgium --- where there were nearly forty starters for a three thousand seven hundred metres cross-country. Chief interest in the race was a question-mark.....would Reiff, the Belgian world-record-holder, stave off the challenge of Britain's wonder boy, Gordon Pirie? The answer was --- "No!"
