Beneath the swords of a guard of honour mounted by the Royal Scots

Greys, the bride comes out from the Abbey on the arm of her groom. He is

Viscount Althorp, son of Earl Spencer. As the Acting Master of the

Royal Household, he accompanied the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh on

their Commonwealth Tour.
