Sir Winston Churchill and Nr Eden were being seen off by Lady
Churchill and Mrs Eden, when they left Lenden Airport on their way to
Washington. This American journey, was for top-level talks with
President Eisenhower and the WaitedxSinker American Secretary of State

The airliner in which they travelled was the Stratecruiser Canepus, which had flown the Queen to Jamaica at the start of her tour of the Commonwealth. Piloting the Canepus was Captain Denaldson, who has flown the Atlantic four hundred and thirty times.
