Germany and Austria- Floods along the Danube- 13/7/54 Upper Bavaria--- This is the tragic aftermath of 60 hours of incessant rain- the flooded countryside Frank Resembeing about 30 miles SE of Manich.

Flying in a policopter over the inundated valleys, we see how the Danube, Inn and ten smaller rivers swept over their banks, completely isolabing farms and homestends over a wide area.

Though heroic rescue work continued, with the water almost half way up the houses, and the coldest July temperatures in living memory of life in Rosenheim became an unpleasant nightmare.

And wooden piles at the Mangfall River Bridge were loosened to prevent the bridge's collapse.
