Canadian mountain power-house

British Columbia: Four hundred miles North of Vancouver - men are battling against the rugged grandeur of the Rockies. A sky-lift cable, over a mile high, takes them to work - building a subterranean power-house - inside a mountain.

The powerhouse is ~~is~~ thirteen stories high and houses ~~eight~~ the turbine - a giant paddle-wheel - that will be driven by water, flowing through a ten-mile mountain tunnel.
