To launch the Shaw Savill liner Southern Cress, Her Majesty the Queen broke her holiday in Scotland, and flow from Aberdeenshire to Belfast.

According to the record, this is the first time a ship of the British Merchant Navy has been immind launched by a reigning maximum menarch.

Upon arrival, the Queen was presented with a bouquet by John Collins, a seventeen-year-old apprentice. Then, escerted by Sir Frederick Rebbeck, Her Majesty went up to the launching platform to perform the ceremeny. The Southern Cross is an unusua. ship; she has been designed to carry passengers only

Twenty thousand tens --- with an everall length of six hundred feet. She will make four veyages a year round the world --- linking Great Britain with the Commonwealth Countries of the Southern Hemisphere --- Australia, New Zealand and South Africa

For the Queen this occasion was a reminder of her great Commonwealth Tour; for the Southern Cross is to be commanded by Sir David Aitchison, captain of the Gothic on that Royal Journey
