But six minutes later the Moscow side scored the equaliserate. Kelsey nearly had it -- but not quite --- and inside right Paramenev drove it home

One all at half-time... An and only a few minutes after the second half opened Tatouchine centred and Simonian got his head to it to make it Spartak 2 --- Arsenal 1.

Now the Gunners turned the heat on --- and now an appeal for a penalty when Milton was brought down was disallowed

Another attack by Arsenal as full-time was appreaching --but the Spartak gealie was safe and steady And the visitors ran out the winners by two goals to one.
