

SUBMARINE. TALENT.

This was the scene at Chatham where the submarine "Talent" --- ~~which~~ undergoing a refit --- was swept out of the deck while more than thirty men were working on board. The cause of the accident was the collapse of a caisson which formed the dock gate. [^]

The submarine ended its wild rush on a mudbank, with its forepart full of water. Most of those on board managed to scramble to safety --- but four men lost their lives.

EVERNIA LAUNCHED.

From John Brown's Yard, Clydebank, the second of three twenty-two-thousand-ton sister ships, was launched for the Cunard Company by the wife of the Canadian Minister of Trade and Commerce.

The liner was named "Ivernia". She will carry nearly a thousand passengers, and cargoes, between Great Britain, Quebec and Montreal.
