

This is the State Penitentiary in Boston, Massachusetts, where four convicts mutinied, holding five guards hostage while demanding release. Finally, the ~~xxxx~~ mutineers agreed to talk with a committee of citizens chosen by themselves; and --- after holding out for more than three days, --- surrendered. <sup>16</sup>/<sub>1</sub>

FRENCH FLOODS.

Among the places worst hit by the floods in Europe, are towns, villages and countryside in the district round Lyon, in France. On the roads by Tournus and Macon --- wheeled traffic has given precedence to anything that floats. The broad acres of French farmlands have disappeared; embankments are scarcely more than a shallower part of the river. <sup>19</sup>/<sub>3</sub>

ST LAWRENCE POWER PROJECT.

From Canada --- the story of a river-flooding that is being devised by man instead of by Nature.
