Sir Winston Churchill was host at No. 10 Downing Street to the other Prime Ministers of the Commonwealth; in London; an early arrival was Australia's Mr Menzies, followed by India's Mr Nehru with his sister. And here --- leading the way in is Mr St Laurent, the Prime Minister of Canada. In his most genial mood, Sir Winston showed his colleagues a framed postal order for five shillings which had been sent to him by an old-age pensioner.

Presently they were joined by Sir Anthony Eden, who opened the discussion on the international situation. And here is Mrs Pandit, the Indian High Commissioner in Lendon.

In the group --- it's Mr St Laurent of Canada seated at Sir Winston's right hand, with Mr Holland of New Zealand next to him.

Standing are Mr Swart of South Africa and Mr Ali of Pakistan; at Sir Winston's left hand is Mr Henzies of Australia --- and behind in Refuseuratives of Car Canada him Sir John Kotelawale of Grand and Sir Galfroy Wassing, of the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland feeling of Mr Nehru Caulal Africa
