## FORMOSA --- EISENHOW MR SIGNS.

Watched by the leaders of Congress, President Eisenhower signed the Resolution passed by the Senate and the Hence of Representatives granting emergency powers to use the armed forces of the United States in defence of Formosa --- if necessary. And here --- at UNO --- the Security Council debate on those danger-zone islands off China. American support was forthcoming for the New Zealand proposate discuss a cease-fire.... but objection was raised by Mr Sobolev, of Soviet Russia. The security voting was nine nations in favour of the discussions --- and one vote against --by Russia.

And now --- to the Formosa Strait..... with a ship of the Chinese Nationalist Navy, bringing refugees from the outlying Tachen Islands to Formosa itself. A grim spectacle, that has become all too familiar; women and children, lost and bewildered; many of the children were orphaned in the opening bombardment from Communist China. Also among the evacuees, were wounded soldiers of the Nationalist Army
