Lined up on the tarmac of the Royal Air Force Station at Wattisham in Suffolk --- these are Hawker Hunters, the newest jetfighters to go into service with the R.A.F. And These pictures which we are about to see of their first public formation flight, co-incide with the Government mithathe White Paper on the Air Defences of Great Britain. A U.S. Air Force Officer who has flown both types, says they are better than the American Sabrefet; their rapid climb on take-off can be seen for itself.
