The splendid building of Kidbrooke School was the meeting-place of important people, when Countess Mountbatten of Burma paid a visit to south-east London to declare the school officially open. This is the school on which work was begun in 1951 at an estimated cost of six hundred and fifty thousand pounds ~~£~~ and actually opened in 1954 with a roll of sixteen hundred and fifty girls. The school is built on a site of ten acres --- with another sixteen acres of playing fields.
