This is Nicosia --- capital of the island of Cyprus off the sourteen coast of Turkey, which has come into the world and headlines with a campaign of resistance to British rule by the demands of some of its inhabitants for union with Greece. British troops patrol the streets of Nicosia and other towns where rioting has occurred --- to enforce the British Government's designated determination to maintain law and order.

The Turkish flag is evidence that there is also here a elsewhere considerable Turkish minority --- and/the Greek flag flies in support of the campaign for Union with Greece, whose leader is the religious head of the island, Archbishop Makarios.

In order to step up security measures, the British Government appointed Field Marshal Sir John Harding as the new Governor Cyprus.

of/ thexixiand. Sir John who had a distinguished career during the war, and was appointed Chief of the Imperial General Staff in 1952, is here being sworn in as the Queen's representative in the island. In an interview, he emphasised the importance of Cyprus as a strategic base.
