The Dark Blues kicked off at Twickenham in the seventy-fourth ruggar match between Oxford and Cambridge --- of which Oxford had won thirty-three and Cambridge twenty-eight, with twelve games drawn. Oxford were favourites, but Cambridge started off by getting most of the ball; and here comes the first try, with Hershaw scoring for the Light Blues.

Hetherington converted --- 5 - nil.

*forward* Still in the first half, Smith, the Oxford stand-off raced the line and it looked certain try. The Dark Blues were awarded a penalty for obstruction --- 5 - 3.

In the second half the Dark Blues produced some sparkling movements; and they went ahead when Walker scored a try to make it 6 - 5.

The Dark Blues pressed home their advantage with another unconverted try before no-side --- and so Oxford won by nine points to five.
