When Sir Anthony Eden arrived in NewYork with Fareign Secretary Mr Selwyb Lleyd, he spoke of his pleasure at the prespect of fresh talks with President Eisenhower.

The President was waiting outside the "hite House to greet his guest, when the Fritish Frime Minister arrived in Washington. A Sir Anthony had already made it known that the discussions with the President were not likely to make headlines. They were merely areatime exchange of views, on outstanding world problems. A the Main engagements to which Sir Anthony looked forward, was his speech to the American Senate and House of Representatives.
