For a few brief minutes --- Government House at Kaduna saw
the royal ceremony of investiture, when the Queen conferred
the honour of knighthood upon the Sultan of Sokote. Another
memorable event of the royal teur of Nigeria was the Queen's
visit to the Lugard Hall --- to receive from the House of Assembly
a layal address. This is the Parliament of Nigeria's Northern
Region --- kharhemarms which is the home of eighteen millions
of her thirry million people. The address was read by the
Premier; and pledged the allegiance of chiefs and emire to the
Crown.

But the most spectacular event so far in the programme of the Royal Nigerian Tour was the great Durbar at Kaduna. In Hundreds sook part in it! --- the contacts thousands came to watchit.

The Queen and the Duke left their car for the royal dais - watched by fierce-looking warriors clad in fairy-book splendour. But there seemed to be only one from the Catering Corps

Then began the music for the march paste,

For more than two hours --- this fantastic cavalcade relled past the Sovereign; chiefs and warriors --- emirs and acrobats and jesters in a whirling kaleidoscope of pageantry; until the final breath-taking charge.
