Prime Minister was staying at Government House; and he took
a walk in the snow-covered grounds with the Governor General
and granddaughter Susan --- to whom Sir Anthony is godfather.
He decided that the Meunty's buffalo coat was just the thing
for that weather. On the following day the British Prime
Minister went to the Canadian Parliament Buildings and
addressed a joint session of the Members.

And so --- to London Airport --- where Mr R.A. Butler was among those on hand for a welcome home to his chief --- and to Foreign Secretary Mr Selwyn Lloyd. Before leaving for Downing Street, Sir Anthony had a word for our newsreel microphones
