QUEENSLAND CYCLONE.

The town of Cairns in the north of Australia's Queensland took the full force of a cyclone in which the winds reached a force of a hundred miles an hour. Schools, churches, homes --- battered and wrecked. ^ Trees, shrubs and crops --- flattened and ruined, in the worst blow for thirty years.

TROOPS IN ALGIERS.
