The town of Cairns in the north of Australia's Queensland took the full force of a cyclone in which the winds reached a force of a hundred miles an hour. Schools, churches, homes --- battered and wrecked. Trees, skrubs and crops --- flattened and ruined in the worst blow for thirty years.

TROOPS IN ALGIERS.

This contingent of five hundred young conscripts was the latest arrival of French tropps as reinforcements in Algiers. Their landing in this North African trouble-centre, co-incided with a fresh outbreak of terrorist activity. New mechanised divisions have also been sent to Algiers. --- at the same time and trouble to a sent the same time.
